#### ALIA (Asian League of Institutes of the Arts)

K-Arts spearheaded the establishment of ALIA in 2012 to enhance higher education in the arts throughout Asia and develop further regional cooperation. K-Arts was designated to be a permanent Board of Director of ALIA in 2016.

#### **ELIA (European League of Institutes of the Arts)**

ELIA is a globally connected network located in the Netherlands that provides a dynamic platform for professional exchange and development in higher arts education. K-Arts' partnership with ELIA facilitates knowledge exchange, international networking, and collaboration.

#### AEC (Association Européenne des Conservatoires, Académies de Musique et Musikhochschulen)

AEC is a voluntary coalition representing higher music education institutions in Europe and beyond. Established in 1953, the AEC works for the advancement of music and arts education, and has around 300 member institutions for professional music training in 57 countries. K-Arts joined AEC in 2022 as its first Korean member institution.

K-Arts offers exchange student opportunities on a semester basis with partner schools overseas, and is open to both undergraduate and graduate students. 
